



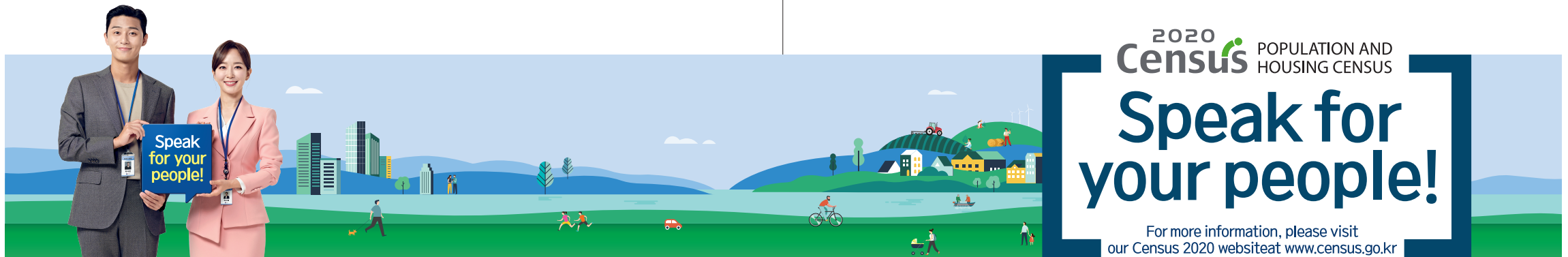

What is the Population and Housing Census?

It is a basic national statistical survey conducted to identify the size and characteristics of all domestic and foreign residents and their housing in Korea. A register-based census on population, households and housing is annually produced based on administrative data, but it is necessary to conduct on-site surveys of 20% of all households in Korea every five years in order to collect practical data required for creating regional policies regarding welfare, economy, and transportation.



What is the Census Used For?

The Population and Housing Census will serve as basic data required for creating national major policies and will be available to every citizens, businesses and the public.

• Basic data required for creating major national policies

- ▷ Calculate local share tax and make comprehensive plans on housing
- ▷ Make mid/long-term projections on the supply and demand of manpower and plans on vitalizing regional economies

• Sample survey population and sample frame

- ▷ Among 292 types of household statistics, 220 (75.3%) used the Census as survey population as of February 2020.



Use of Census Data

• Production of secondary derived statistics

- ▷ Estimate the future trends in population and households (Statistics Korea)
- ▷ Produce low-fertility and aging index, housing supply ratio and other statistics



• Data for private research and business management

- ▷ Basic data for research by universities and research institutes and for enterprises' management
 - The number of Microdata uses (2019): 3,566
 - The number of KOSIS (Korean Statistical Information Service) uses (2019): 9.886 million



What is the 2020 Population and Housing Census?

Basic survey items are supplemented by administrative data. Only for hard-to-replace survey items, we visit and survey 20% of the population residing in Korea. The on-site survey comprises 45 items, with some items newly added such as caring for those with a physical or mental condition that limits movements, fire-fighting facilities, drinking water, period of living alone and pets.

[The on-site survey will be conducted online and through in-person visits]

▶ Online Census: October 15-31 ▶ In-person interviews: November 1-18
